Have your say – Draft Preferred Futures Report out for comment now

The Draft Preferred Futures Report has just been released for public feedback. This report is a significant milestone for the Shore Futures project.

The report will be of interest to anyone who lives, owns property, works or holidays in the Kawhia and Aotea catchments. We encourage you to have a look at the report and provide comment on it. The deadline for feedback on the report is Monday 13 July 2009.

The report focuses on a number of recommended actions that will help manage change within the Kawhia and Aotea catchments and harbours. Feedback is sought particularly on the last chapter of the report, which covers the recommended actions and who they will be implemented by.
