Hamilton City Council is undertaking an education programme with practical outcomes relating to the restoration of privately owned gully areas in the city.

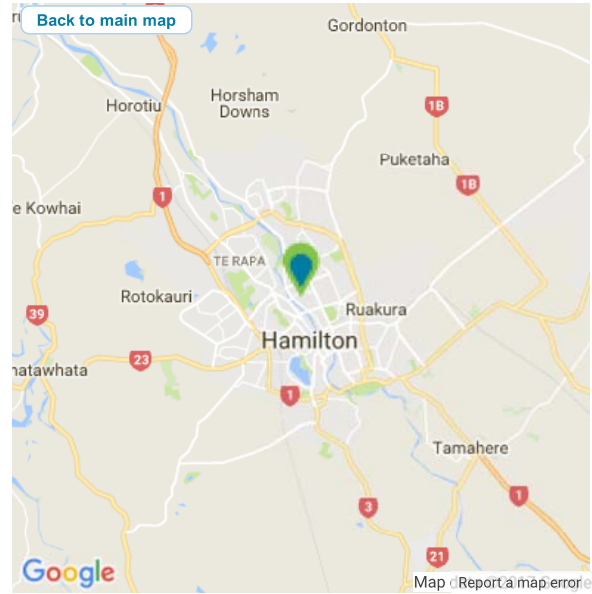
This is a prioritised catchment based approach to cleaning up our streams.

This project will benefit the community and help with education of landowners whose properties back onto gullies within the Hamilton boundary.

This is important because of the 87km of streams and open drains within the City 59km are located on private property. Most of these streams are part of the gully network owned by over 3000 Hamilton residents.
