

#### Plan Overview

- Genesis in The Sustainable Farming Fund "Green Tick" programme in mid 90's
- B+LNZ created the Land Environment Plans level 1, 2 &3
- Workshops conducted early 2010.
- Across many regions there has been progress to a "Farm Environment Plan"
- In collaboration with the WRC the Waikato Farm Environment Plan developed in 2017.
- Consultants made this template workshop ready in 2017.

Farmer created with Farmer knowledge of their own land


**Land Management Units**



Industry good bodies (DINZ) to create targeted discussion groups.




# Farm Environment Plans and sub catchment



Farm Environment Plans are critical in sub catchment planning

### Relief Sought



- Have Farm Environment plans that are created by Farmers as the regulatory imposition.
- Have the FEP's verified only by a 3rd party
- Ensure the process contains the 4 detailed steps.
- Create an atmosphere of farmer to farmer learning
- Build on the evolution of Farm Environment planning and sub catchment involvement.

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
