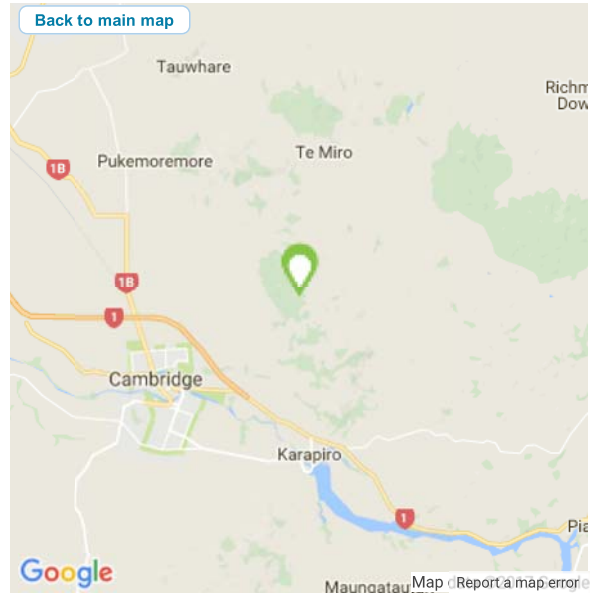
The Friends of Sanatorium Hill are affiliated to Tui 2000 and have gained great support from Cambridge locals.

Located in the Maungakawa Reserve, 15 minutes from Cambridge, the busy volunteers have established a healthy example of an under-represented tawa dominated forest.

The site has a rich diversity with many different features of historical, environmental and recreational nature. The forest is dominated by tawa with mahoe, broadleaf, rewarewa, tanekaha, kawakawa, pukatea, emerging rimu and supplejack all found within the 52 hectare reserve.

It's well worth a visit and if you can spare a few hours there is usually planting planned with plenty of weeding to do!
