PROJECTS FUNDED IN THE 2022 FUNDING ROUND

ABOUT THIS FUNDING ROUND

In the 2022/23 Natural Heritage Fund (NHF) round grants totalling \$2,051,357 were made to the following four applications.

MAUNGATAUTARI ECOLOGICAL ISLAND TRUST

Project: Sharing the Mauri and Mana of Maungatautari
District: Waipa
NHF Contribution: \$1,467,275
Duration of Funding: 4 years

This funding requested will support maintaining the pest proof fence and to detect and remove pest animals that breach the sanctuary fence.

THAMES COAST KIWI CARE INCORPORATED

Project: Expanding Thames Coast Predator Control and Habitat Protection
District: Thames-Coromandel
NHF Contribution: \$270,000
Duration of Funding: 4 years

This funding will support operational labour for mustelid control, setting up new bait stations and traplines, and for the inclusion of possum and rat control work.

WAIKATO ENVIRONMENT CENTRE TRUST

Project: Bush to Burbs
District: Waipa
NHF Contribution: \$129,517
Duration of Funding: 3 years

This funding will support the purchase of traps and a small amount of advocacy and liaison staff labour costs.

MAHAKIRAU FOREST ESTATE SOCIETY

Project: Trilogy of Treasured Taonga
District: Thames-Coromandel
NHF Contribution: \$184,565
Duration of Funding: 4 years

This funding will support the cost of pest control contractors, materials and the preparation of the species biodiversity management plans.
