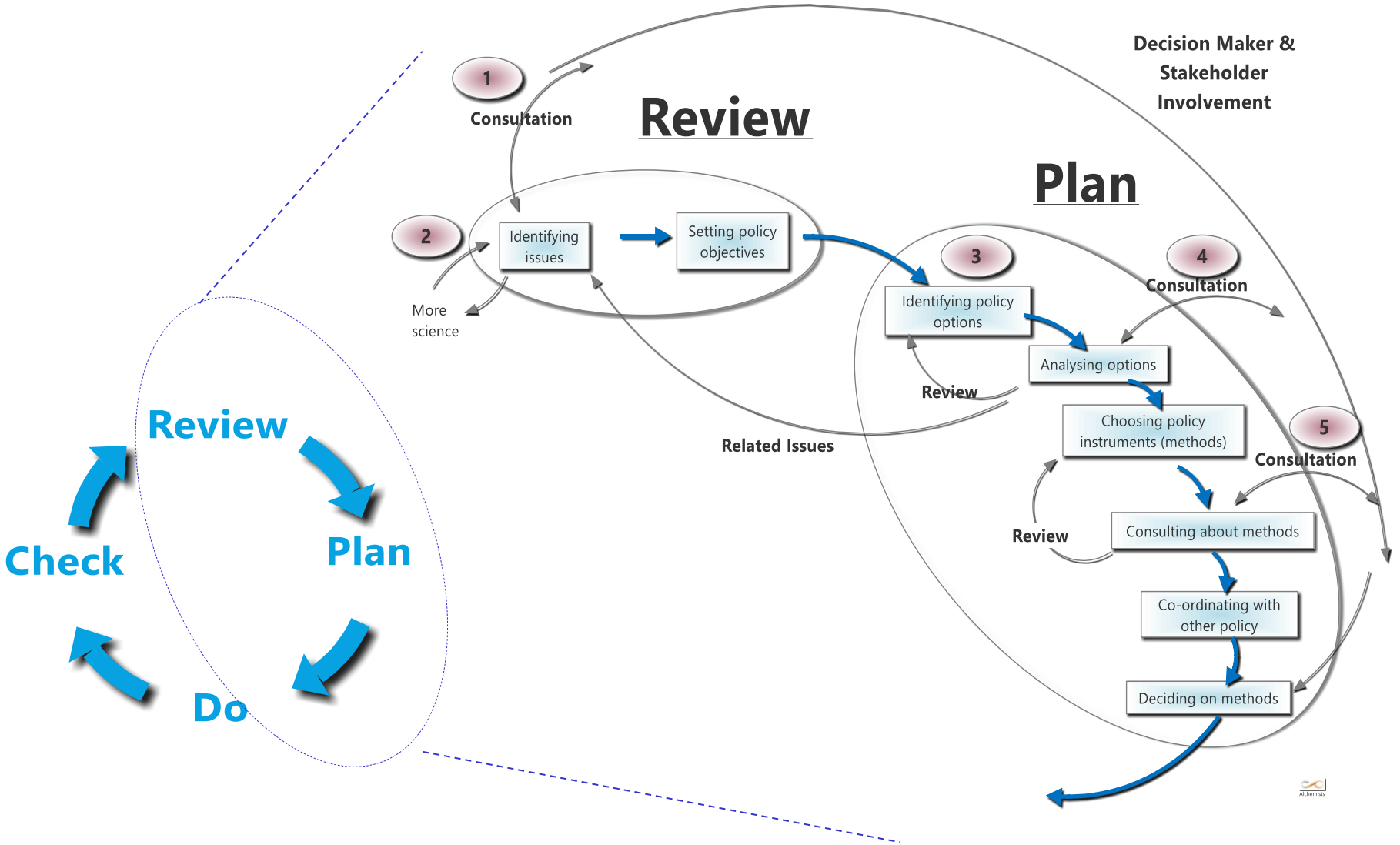

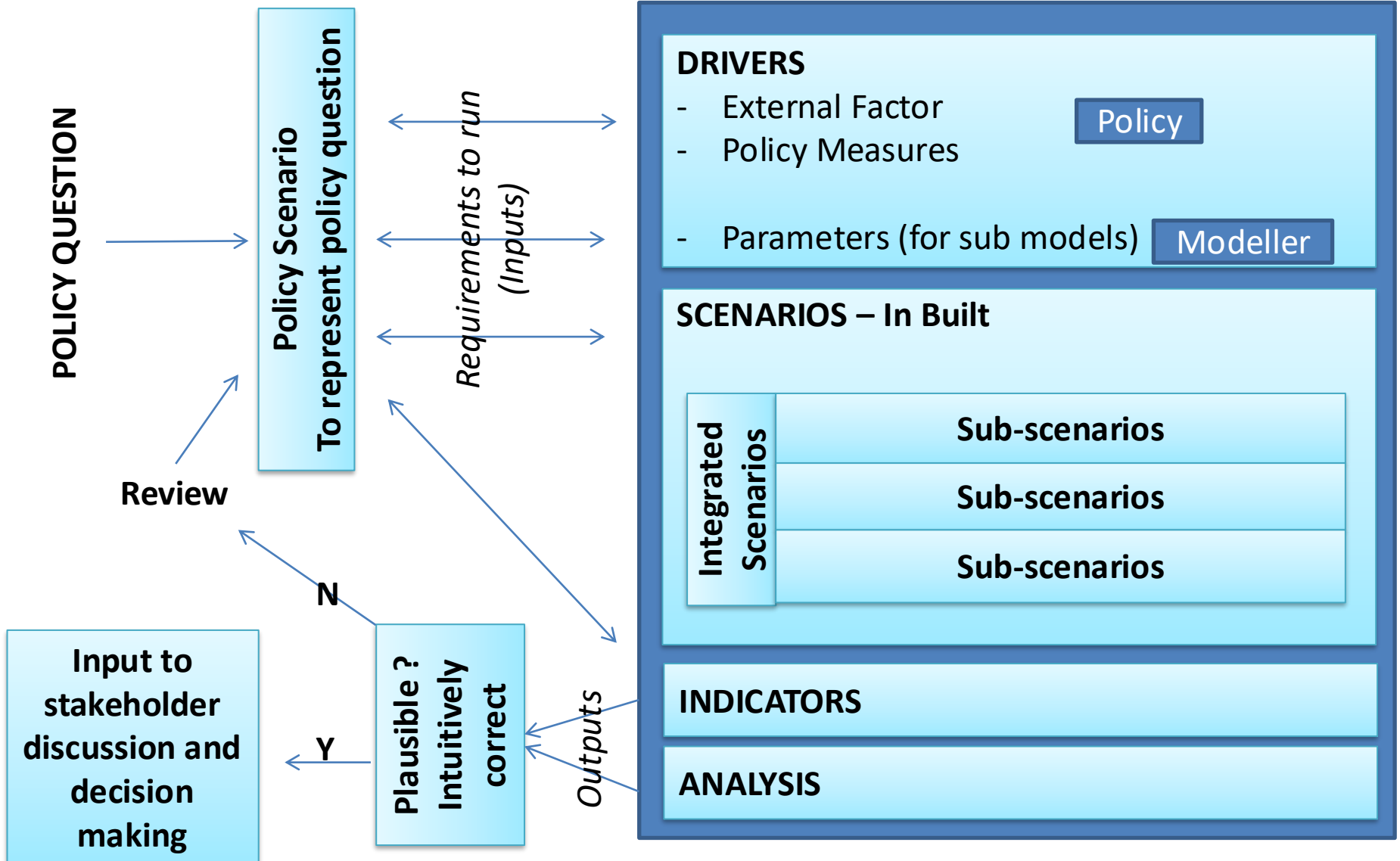

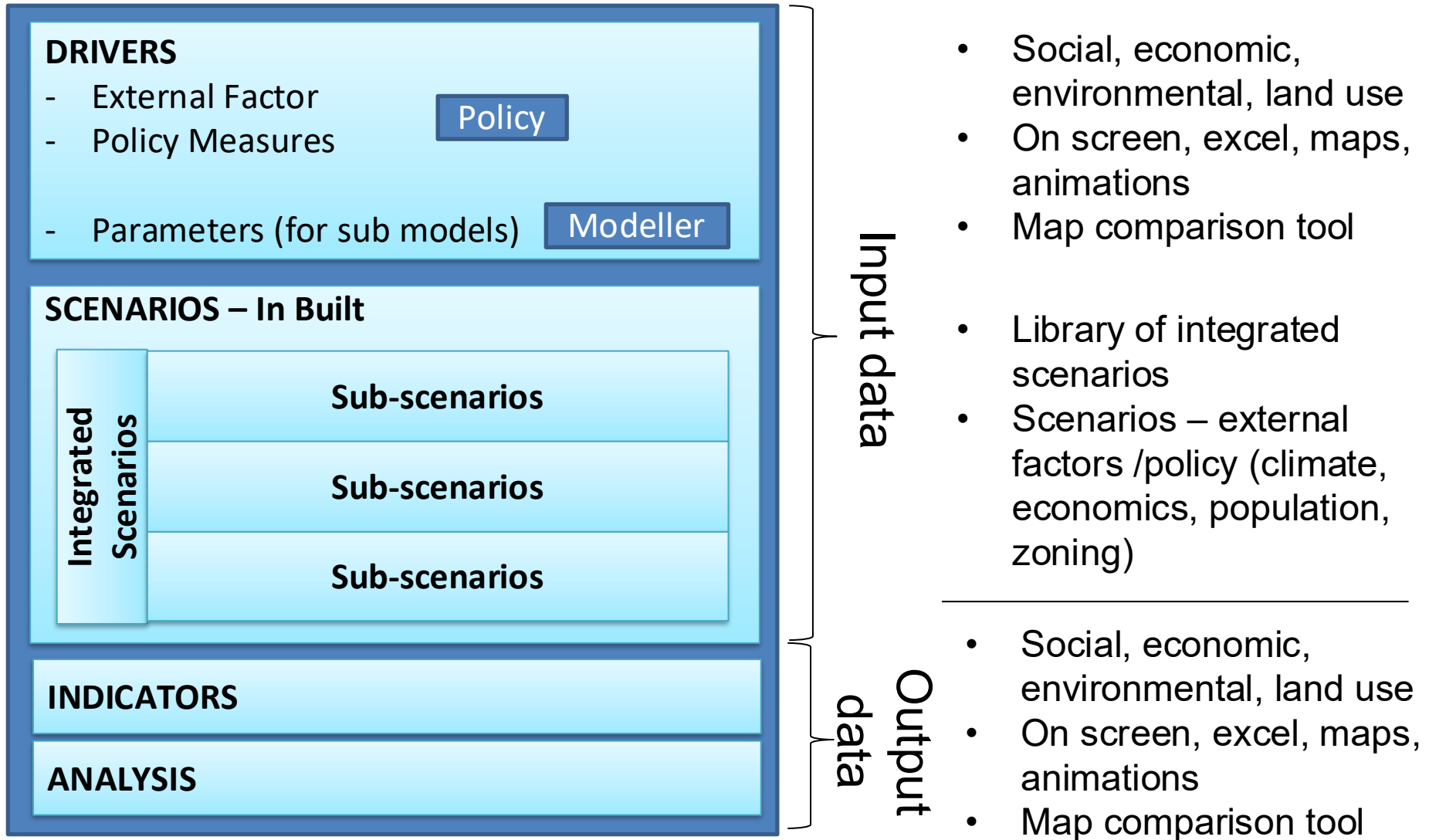
WISE – Supporting Decision Making

- Concept testing vs detailed scenario

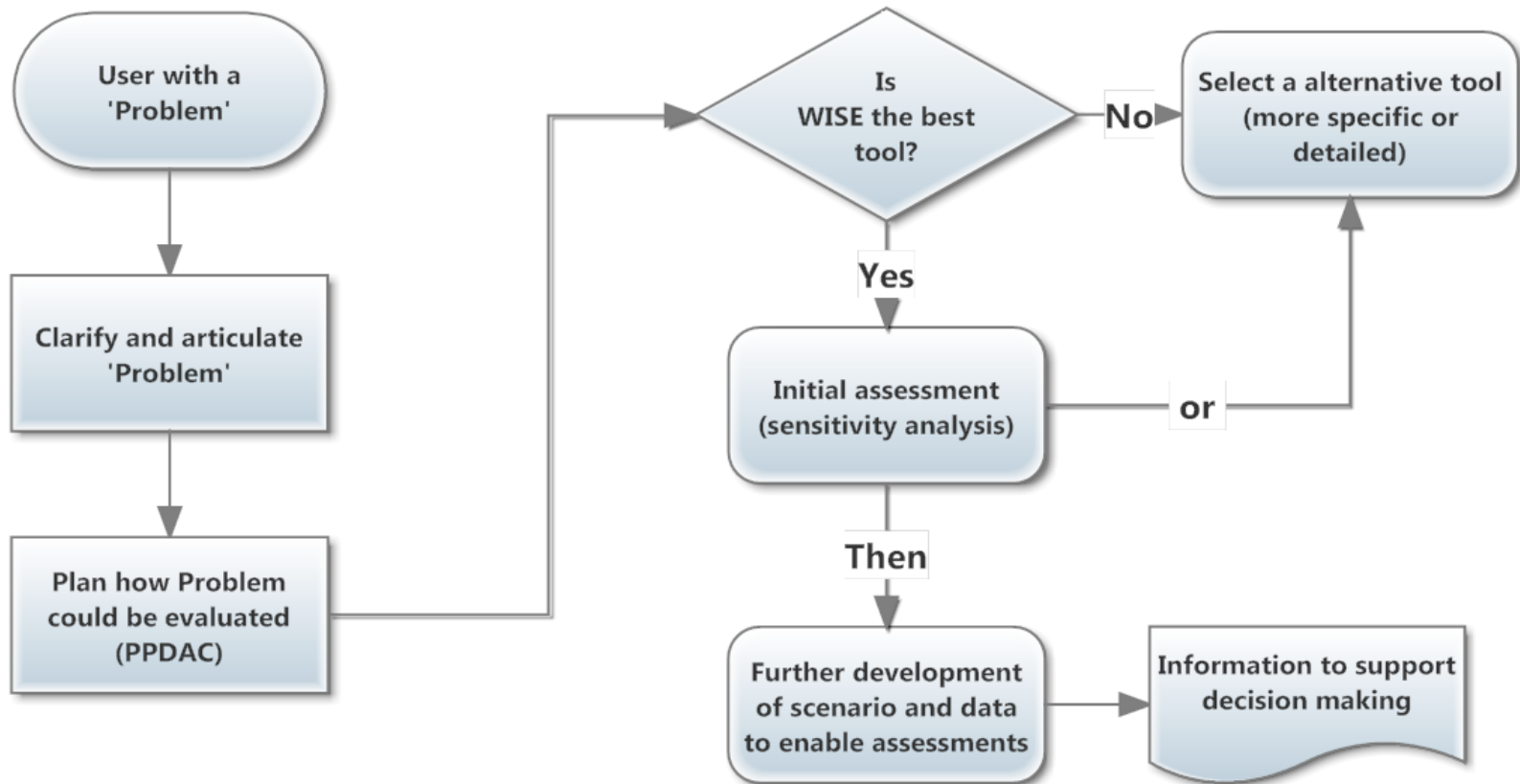


PPDAC Framework
