


Celebrating Earth Day

WORLD FINGERPRINT ART

The **22nd of April each year is 'Earth Day'**, and 2020 marks 50 years of acknowledging the day! Why not commemorate by making a beautiful collaborative piece of art that celebrates Papatūānuku and creates time to connect with each other.

How to create your fingerprint world:

- 1) Roughly sketch the world on a piece of paper or card
- 2) Each person involved picks a colour and colours their spots (blues for the oceans, greens, yellow and browns for the land)
- 3) While you are working on this, why not think have a chat about:
 - Where are your favourite places on Earth?
 - What actions you already take as a bubble/ family/ whānau to look after the planet?
 - What further actions you can take to protect the Earth?
