

Make a Wind Chime (An upcycled gift idea)

What do you have around home that could clink together and make a peaceful sound?

Here's some ideas:

- Empty (washed) tin cans from recycling bin
- Seashells
- Driftwood
- Sticks
- Old disused keys
- Old metal toys
- Seed pods
- Old spoons, forks

What to do:

- 1. Collect your materials
- 2. Use a hammer and nail or drill to make a hole in each item. (Ask an adult for help if you need it)
- 3. Thread wool or string through the hole in each item and tie a hole behind the knot to secure it.
- 4. Tie the other end of the string to a stick. Add several items close enough together to bump each other.
- 5. Tie the stick to a tree branch so the wind can blow it.
